

FOREST RIDGE YOUTH SERVICES SUGGESTED CLOTHING INVENTORY

- 2 sets sleepwear
 - 7 pair underpants
 - 3 bras (females) and 2 sports bras
 - 7 pair socks
 - 3 pair shorts
 - 3 pair jeans
 - 5 shirts/blouses suitable for school
 - 3 sweaters/sweatshirts suitable for school
 - 2 PE Outfits (shorts/pants and shirt)
 - 1 pair tennis shoes for physical activities
 - 1 pair dress shoes
 - 1 pair sweatpants or windpants
 - 1 light weight jacket
 - 1 heavy winter coat
 - 1 pair winter boots
 - 1 stocking cap and pair gloves/mittens

It is the policy of Forest Ridge to allow a student to bring personal possessions and to acquire belongings, as determined in the student's case plan. The only limit would be space restrictions and possessions which are not allowed under the following guidelines:

INAPPROPRIATE POSSESSIONS:

A. The following items are not approved for use or wear at Forest Ridge. If they are brought to Forest Ridge they will be placed in a locked area until arrangements are made to return them to the referring worker or to the student's parent/guardians. In the event that these items are brought on campus, Forest Ridge is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

1. Clothing which displays drug, alcohol, or music related logos or sayings
2. Clothing or other items which display satanic or gang related symbols or emblems
3. Dangling earrings, other body piercing jewelry
4. Clothing which is torn, tattered, or revealing
5. CD's or MP3's of inappropriate, unapproved music
6. Valuable jewelry or other possessions such as MP3 players
7. Any drug, alcohol or tobacco product
8. Any weapon, knife or protective devices (such as mace, pepper gas, etc.)

B. Students will be supplied with all of their necessary daily living needs while at Forest Ridge.
